

and each student-athlete from the 2015-2016 team. After the evening's festivities, guests were treated to a souvenir gift on their way out, and left looking forward to the upcoming season.



The weekend's events began on Friday, with a hosted tour of the Jackie Robinson Athletics Complex, including Pauley Pavilion, Spaulding Field, the UCLA Football locker room, Acosta Training Room, Drake Stadium and the UCLA Athletics Hall of Fame.

That evening, there was a team reunion dinner held at a private residence in Brentwood, where the team got to catch up further with their former teammates. After dinner, each team member was presented with a commemorative Rose Bowl Championship ring. The National Letter of Intent early signing period starts next Wednesday, November 11 for UCLA sports except Football, Soccer and Men's Water Polo. Traditional media, Internet blogs and social media will be outlets for information and discussion on where recruits will be signing.

Since all recruiting activity must be done exclusively by the UCLA coaching staff, please note the following important NCAA restrictions regarding social media, the Internet and electronic

1. UCLA boosters are not permitted to write, call, instant or direct message, text, chat

contacting that prospect. This restriction includes using the inbox/email feature on Facebook and "@replies," "mentions," "tweeting" or "retweeting" on Twitter.

Is it permissible for a UCLA donor to contact a prospect or his/her parents after the signing of an NLI? No. A booster may not call, text or email a prospect or his/her parents even if the purpose of the call is only to congratulate the prospect on signing with UCLA. This

2. UCLA boosters are not permitted to use social networking websites, including Twitter, Facebook or Instagram to contact or otherwise attempt to correspond with prospects. 3. Boosters may not initiate or accept "friend" requests of prospects on Facebook and should never post to a prospect's "wall" or take any other action that would constitute
