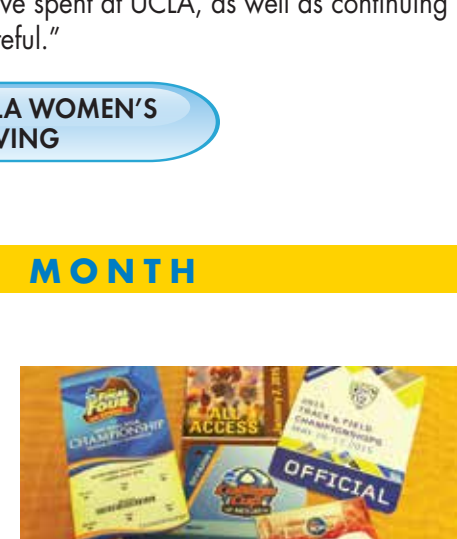

Postseason Game Tickets

Everyone loves to watch the Bruins all season, and our top student-athletes and coaches find themselves, many times, heading into postseason play. Whether it is a Bowl game, the NCAA Tournament, or the College World Series, if you are passionate about the team and would like to see the Bruins continue on their postseason path, you will need tickets. Since postseason events are not UCLA-run, but usually NCAA-run, the methods by which one obtains UCLA tickets are different. The question then becomes: how does one get tickets to postseason games and events?



The answer is two-fold. First, ALL Wooden Athletic Fund members have the first opportunity to request postseason and special event seats before they go on sale to the general public. Secondly, all postseason and special athletic event tickets are allocated based upon WAF donor level, your lifetime giving to UCLA Athletics, and your consecutive years of season ticket purchase.

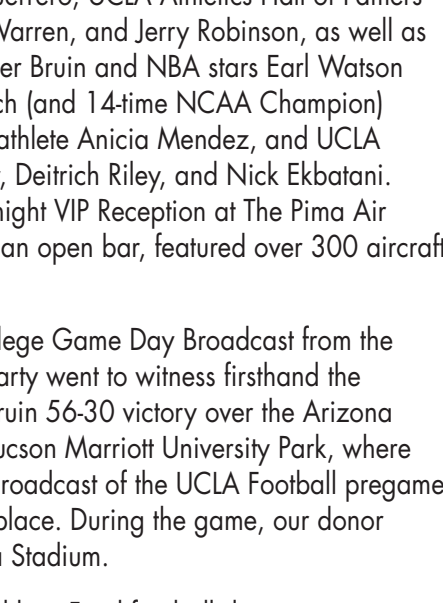

There are many Planned Giving gift arrangement options that can help you establish a personal and permanent legacy; these include Charitable Gift Annuities, Charitable Remainder Trusts, UCLA Donor Advised Funds, and many more. Most importantly, your contribution will help support our Bruin student-athletes and can also immediately begin to benefit you and your family.



Many donors who believe in the transformative power of athletics and education choose to make a legacy gift through their wills or living trusts. Others achieve their philanthropic goals through arrangements that provide them with an income stream for life and Athletics with a future gift. There are many flexible and accessible ways to set up a legacy gift and use a variety of assets, such as real estate, cash, appreciated stock, life insurance, or retirement funds. Many options result in estate tax savings, or generate income, or provide significant income tax advantages.

Regarding her planned gift to UCLA Athletics, longtime supporter Jody Chapman (UCLA '58 and '59, Physical Education) said, "My goal is to generate at least one ongoing scholarship for each women's sport. In my era, there were no collegiate athletic competitions for women at UCLA. Since then, UCLA has played a leading role in promoting athletics for women and that's what initiated my interest in this program. I think planned gift arrangements are a win-win: both the school and the donor benefit. For example, annuity payments augment my income and I enjoy having a positive impact during my lifetime."

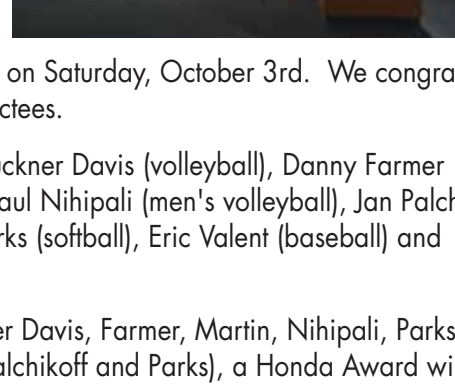
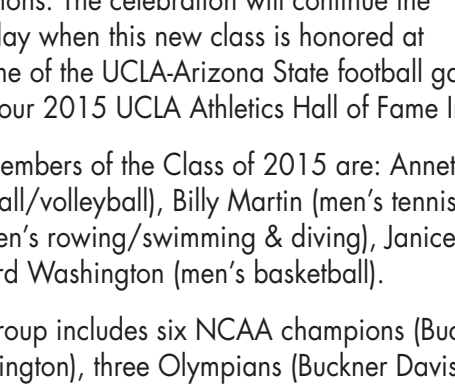
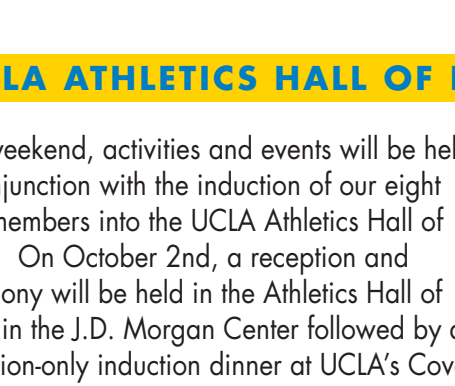
EVENT RECAP

UCLA vs. Arizona Football Donor Trip - September 25 - 27, 2015

Last month, UCLA Athletics and the Wooden Athletic Fund chartered two flights to Tucson, Arizona. 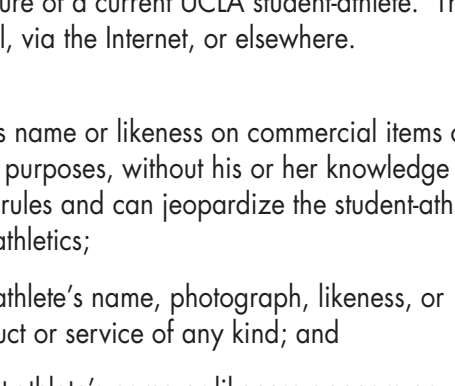
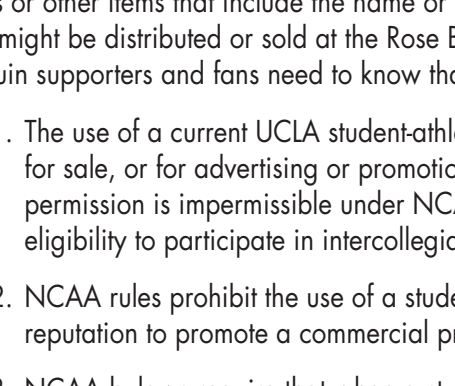
UPCOMING EVENT

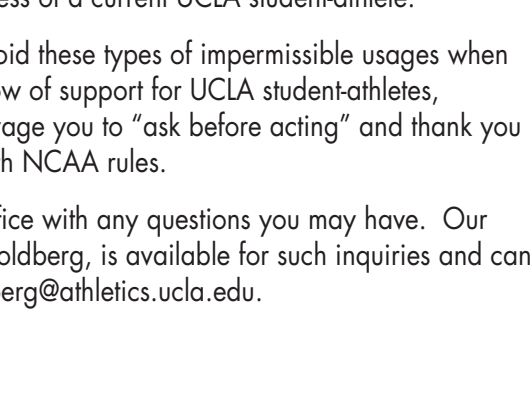

This weekend, activities and events will be held in conjunction with the induction of our eight new members into the UCLA Athletics Hall of Fame. On October 2nd, a reception and ceremony will be held in the Athletics Hall of Fame in the J.D. Morgan Center followed by an invitation-only induction dinner at UCLA's Covel Commons. The celebration will continue the next day when this new class is honored at half of the UCLA-Arizona State football game on Saturday, October 3rd. We congratulate all of our 2015 UCLA Athletics Hall of Fame Inductees.



The members of the Class of 2015 are: Annett Buckner Davis (volleyball), Danny Farmer (football/volleyball), Billy Martin (men's tennis), Paul Nihipali (men's volleyball), Jan Palchikoff (women's washing/swimming & diving), Janice Parks (softball), Eric Valent (baseball) and Richard Rowing (men's basketball).

The group includes six NCAA champions (Buckner Davis, Farmer, Martin, Nihipali, Parks and Washington), three Olympians (Buckner Davis, Palchikoff and Parks), a Honda Award winner (Parks), two Pac-10 Players of the Year (Buckner and Valent) and a NCAA Tournament MVP (Washington). The class as a whole totaled 11 national team and individual championships at UCLA (Buckner Davis and Washington each with one team, Martin with a singles title and one team title each as a player and a coach, and Farmer, Parks and Nihipali each with two team titles).

UCLA ATHLETICS' COMPLIANCE CORNER

Impermissible Use of UCLA Student-Athletes' Names and Likenesses

The growing excitement and support for Bruin teams sometimes result in the production of t-shirts, towels or other items that include the name or picture of a current UCLA student-athlete. These items might be distributed or sold at the Rose Bowl, via the Internet, or elsewhere. All Bruin supporters and fans need to know that:

1. The use of a current UCLA student-athlete's name or likeness on commercial items offered for sale, or for advertising or promotional purposes, without his or her knowledge or permission is impermissible under NCAA rules and can jeopardize the student-athlete's eligibility to participate in intercollegiate athletics;
2. NCAA rules prohibit the use of a student-athlete's name, photograph, likeness, or reputation to promote a commercial product or service of any kind; and
3. NCAA bylaws require that when a student-athlete's name or likeness appears on commercial items, or is used to promote a commercial item sold by an individual without the student-athlete's knowledge or permission, the student-athlete (or UCLA acting on behalf of the student-athlete) must take steps to stop that activity in order for the student-athlete to retain his or her eligibility.

Bruin student-athletes often achieve "celebrity" status through their athletic achievements. Because of this, individuals and businesses may be tempted to use a student-athlete's name, image, or likeness to promote themselves for financial gain or notoriety. Though it may have the best of intentions, even producing and distributing t-shirts free of charge is contrary to NCAA rules if the shirts include the name, image or likeness of a current UCLA student-athlete.

As UCLA supporters, it is your responsibility to avoid these types of impermissible usages when promoting a business or personal interest or a show of support for UCLA student-athletes, including on social media. As always, we encourage you to "ask before acting" and thank you for your role in helping UCLA Athletics comply with NCAA rules.
