Your investment in our student-athletes is positioning our nearly 400 student-athletes in 16 sports for success in the classroom, on the fields of play, and ultimately in the game of life.

During the 2017-2018 academic year, our athletics teams achieved the university's highest ranking ever in the Learfield Director's Cup standings, finishing 78th out of more than 350 NCAA Division I programs. We also had an outstanding year academically with an average student-athlete GPA for Fall 2017 and Spring 2018 of 3.25, the highest average studentathlete GPA ever at Utah State. When you use these two objective measures of success, the result is the best athletic/academic year in Utah State history. This high level of academic and athletic success for our student-athletes is not possible without the generous support of loyal supporters like you.

Athletically, the men's tennis team captured its third consecutive Mountain West Championship and won its second consecutive Mountain West Tournament, earning the team's second-straight NCAA Championship berth. Track & field qualified a record six athletes to the NCAA Outdoor National Championships with each earning All-American honors. Cross country qualified both the men's and women's squads to the NCAA Championships for the first time in school history. The women finished 14th in the nation, while the men finished 27th. Football played in the NOVA Home Loans Arizona Bowl, marking the sixth bowl game for the Aggies over the past seven seasons.

Academically, Utah State had 159 student-athletes recognized as academic all-Mountain West, 115 student-athletes recognized as Mountain West Scholar Athletes, while 218 student-athletes were honored at the Joe E. and Elma Whitesides luncheon with a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or better. The men's basketball team earned an NABC team academic excellence award, while women's volleyball earned the American Volleyball Coaches Association Team Academic Award. The men's and women's track & field teams were recognized as all-academic teams by the U.S. Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association and the men's and women's tennis teams were recognized as all-academic teams by the U.S. track as all-academic teams by the Intercolleguate Tennis Association.

GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

BIG BLUE SCHOLARSHIP FUND SUPPORT*:

The greatest needs within the athletics department are the resources to provide tuition, fees, room and board, books, and academic support to our student-athletes. All Big Blue Scholarship Fund gifts to Aggies Unlimited impact each and every scholarship student-athlete and are included in a member's annual giving.

PRIORITY SEATING PROGRAM:

Purchasing season tickets in certain locations requires an annual unrestricted contribution to Aggies Unlimited. This per seat annual requirement is in addition to the price of the season ticket. Priority Seating requirements vary depending on the seat location. For 2018, priority seating contributions are included in member's annual giving.

MERLIN OLSEN FUND*:

Gifts to the Merlin Olsen Fund are restricted gifts that are specifically used to enhance the position of Utah State Football by providing resources for recruiting, coaches' salaries and operational support.

WAYNE ESTES FUND*:

Gifts to the Wayne Estes Fund are restricted gifts that are specifically used to enhance the position of Utah State Men's Basketball by providing resources for recruiting, coaches' salaries, and operational support.

A-CLUB*:

An organization exclusively for Utah State University former student-athletes, spirit squad members, coaches, athletic trainers and team managers. Those eligible may contribute directly to the A-Club or any philanthropic Aggies Unlimited funds.

SPORT EXCELLENCE FUNDS*:

Gifts can be made to any of USU Athletics' Excellence Funds. These gifts will help support each program above and beyond any operational expenses.

*GIFTS TO THESE FUNDS ARE PHILANTHROPIC AND TAX-DEDUCTIBLE. SUBSEQUENTLY, THEY DO NOT APPLY TO ANY PRIORITY SEATING REQUIREMENTS.

COMMON DONOR PROFILES

AGGIES UNLIMITED PRIORITY POINTS

Aggies Unlimited Priority Points exist to reward those individuals that have made a commitment to Aggie Athletics. There are many ways to accumulate priority points. Points are calculated on a regular basis and are used to determine selection order for season ticket locations, parking, away game allocation, seat improvements, and other special events or activities. You can start by becoming a member of Aggies Unlimited by making an annual donation of at least \$50.

II. PRIORITY POINT RANKING

Donors will be ranked by priority point total. Points and rank will be updated throughout the year for the purpose of seat improvements, parking, and postseason ticket allocation for football and men's basketball.



DONATIONS HISTORICAL GIVING TO ATHLETICS (1988-2013)*

- One point for every \$100 given to athletics from 1988-2013 (Includes all athletics philanthropic giving funds, endowment, irrevocable planned gifts, special projects, and excellence funds)
- *Athletics giving data not available prior to 1988

PRIORITY SEATING

One point for every \$100 given for priority seating

ANNUAL GIVING

• Two points for every \$100 given to all athletics philanthropic funds

SEASON TICKETS SEASON TICKET HOLDER (BEGINNING WITH 2014)

- One point for every consecutive year as a season ticket holder for football
- One point for every consecutive year as a season ticket holder for men's basketball

OTHER

Ten points for lettering in a varsity sport (20 point max per account)

Two points for USU Alumni (four point max per account)

TRADE/GIFTS IN KIND

One point for every \$300 worth of goods or services donated to Aggie Athletics

BLUE A SOCIETY

THE BLUE A SOCIETY (BAS) provides the philanthropic leadership for Utah State Athletics. The purpose of the BAS is to increase philanthropic revenues for USU Athletics, supporting operational needs and capital priorities. - USU Athletics will establish its top priorities, but BAS members will have the flexibility
 to designate their gift to the fund of their choice. These funds may include, but are not
 limited to: Aggies Unlimited, Big Blue Scholarship Fund, Merlin Olsen Fund, Wayne Estes
 Fund, Capital Funds, and Excellence Funds. Each BAS member pledges his or her support
 for a five-year period to USU Athletics at a minimum of \$25,000 or philanthropic gifts
 annually at \$25,000 or more.
- While the program is philanthropic in nature, BAS members will enjoy unique stewardship opportunities based on giving levels. Membership in the BAS has many advantages, but the biggest perk is knowing that your gift will have an impact on generations of Aggies to come.
